

Waiting timeline:

how long did we wait for the constitution of the Assembly?

Usually, one month passed from the parliamentary elections until the constitution of the new convocation of the Assembly of Serbia. It usually took longer to announce the official results of the elections, then to hold a constitutive session. The average waiting time over the past 19 years is 35 days. We have been waiting for more than that three times: for the first time in 1997, and then almost twenty years later, during the formation of the last two convocations of the Assembly. The longest wait was in 1997, when the Fourth convocation of the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia was formed two and a half months after the elections.

The Speaker of the Parliament has been elected on the same day when the Assembly was constituted a total of four times since 1991, which is one third of the convocations constituted to this day. The election of the Speaker of the Parliament was usually awaited from three to seven days, and a total of three times more than a week. The record was set by the formation of the Seventh convocation in 2007, when the election of Tomislav Nikolić was waited for almost three months (82 days), but he remained in that position for only seven days. The election of the Speaker of the Parliament was awaited for almost two months during the formation of the Ninth convocation in the summer of 2012, when Nebojša Stefanović was elected to that position.

The total numbers shown in the square represent the number of days from the Election Day until the announcement of the final results and the number of days from the announcement of the final results until the constitutive session.
